

Physics Graduate Student Travel Support

The UNT Department of Physics is pleased to provide an application for up to \$500 of student travel support.* The following should be considered minimum requirements:

- You must be pursuing an MS or PhD degree with a major in Physics at UNT.
- You may receive support applied toward your travel expenses from the Department of Physics no more than one time each fiscal year (September 1 - August 31).
- You must be presenting your own research results at a professional scientific conference that is held outside of the DFW area and that you must travel to.
- You must have already applied for a College of Science travel award for the same travel. (See: <https://cos.unt.edu/scholarships/graduate-student-travel-award.html>)
- You must have already applied for a Graduate School travel award for the same travel. (See: <https://tgs.unt.edu/new-current-students/graduate-student-travel-award.html>)
- Your major professor must be a Physics faculty member and must provide funds toward your travel in an amount no less than the amount you request from the department. [This requirement is waived if your major professor has less than \$5k in funds (including F&A indirect cost recovery funds) that could be used to pay for travel.]
